VITA CAN SAVE YOU VALUABLE FUNDS

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax help to people who generally make \$55,000 or less persons w/disabilities and limited English speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their tax returns. IRS certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing of Federal and State returns. If you earned \$55,000 or less last year, you may qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC). Inquire at VITA site.

WHEN WILL I GET MY REFUND?

IRS refunds that include tax credit payments such as the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC), and the Child Tax Credit will be issued after Feb. 15. This include returns being processed at paid preparer sites.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THESE DOCUMENTS

- Valid photo ID
- Copy of last year's Federal & State returns
- Social Security #s or ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification) #s for you & anyone else on your tax return
- Documentation for ALL income, Social Security or pensions, including forms W-2, 1099-R
- Education expenses & student loan payments, 1098T
- Payments for child care. Bring day care provider's address and tax ID number
- Bank routing & account numbers to direct deposit your refund
- Mortgage 1098 form & receipts of property & car taxes paid
- Mortgage expenses and/or interest paid
- Access Health CT forms, 1095A, copy of health insurance form 1095B or C
- Identity theft PIN # if applicable
